GUIDELINES FOR ONLINE MODE OF SCHOOL

The Covid-19 pandemic has led teachers and students to adopt the online mode for teaching and learning. We at Delhi Public School-Rohini are committed to providing high-quality education, ensuring overall well-being and developing the all-round personality of students.

The school expects the following guidelines and rules to be followed by Students and Parents.

GUIDELINES FOR STUDENTS DURING ONLINE CLASS

“Discipline is the bridge between goals and accomplishment” – Jim Rohn

The school expects students to display utmost regard for the rules and regulations of the institution and maintain a high standard of online academic discipline. Although the classroom is now virtual, the school expects the same standards of behaviour as were followed on campus. The students are expected to go through the guidelines and rules given below before attending online classes and keep them in mind at all times.

Rules for strict compliance:

- ✓ **Microsoft Teams is a platform to be used for hosting virtual classes only by the teachers of Delhi Public School-Rohini. Any activity other than attending of online classes by students using the Login Id provided to them by the school will be viewed seriously and will be subject to a serious disciplinary action.**
 - ✓ **In case any unwarranted online activity of any student amounts to any offence or violation of any law, the liability for such violation will be of the individual only and Delhi Public School-Rohini and/or administrators of Microsoft Teams will not be responsible in any manner.**
 - ✓ **Disciplinary action will be taken against students misusing the Microsoft Teams platform for purpose other than attending a class scheduled by the teacher.**
 - ✓ **The online classes/assemblies are being conducted by the school for students. No one is permitted to record (or take screenshots) any of the online classes for any purpose, through Audio or Video, in any eventuality whatsoever. Any violation shall be strictly construed as infringement and violation of privacy and shall invite all the legal consequences thereof.**
 - ✓ **Students must not indulge in Cyber Bullying in any form. Cyber Bullying refers to “bullying or harassment of any kind inflicted through electronic or communication devices such as computers, mobile phones, laptops, and may involve text messages, phone calls, e-mails, instant messengers or social media platforms”.**
- Students must join the classes using their login id only. They should be very careful and not share their id and password with anyone.
 - Links to class must not be shared with anyone.

- Students must be regular and punctual for the online class. They must be attentive and maintain decorum at all times.
- The student must immediately switch on video and audio for interaction\attendance as and when instructed by the teacher.
- No student is allowed to unmute or share screen unless instructed by the teacher.
- The language used for communication with the teacher on the chat should be polite and courteous.
- Students must be dressed properly and choose a well-lit, noise-free area of the house for attending the class.
- Students must focus on the content being taught, take notes and refrain from opening other windows or surfing the internet.
- Students must maintain class notebooks and submit assignments\project work on time.
- Students must bear in mind that the teacher has the right to remove a student from the online class on account of any act of indiscipline or suspicion of any undesired action by the student.

GUIDELINES FOR PARENTS

Communication with the school

- Parents must mail all applications, concerns and requests to the school mail id (mail@dpsrohini.com).
- Parents must log on to the school web portal from time to time as all important information regarding the schedule of online classes, examination, Open House, workshops, change in syllabus and announcement of untimely holidays is always communicated through the homepage of the school portal.
- Parents must carefully go through the newsletter uploaded in the student login at the start of every unit.
- Parents are advised to maintain close contact with the school for optimum benefit of their wards.
- Open House which is being held in the online mode must be attended by the parents so that the teacher can apprise them about the progress of their ward.
- Even though the classes are being held in the virtual mode, leave applications must be promptly mailed to the school.
- Any change in the phone no/email id/postal address must be updated in the school records at the earliest.
- All complaints/grievances must be brought to the notice of the Class Teacher / Coordinator / Senior-Coordinator /Vice Principal /Principal without any fear of retaliation.

Monitoring the ward in the online environment

Students are now spending more time than ever over the internet. Though internet and its services have been of great help in these times, we cannot afford to ignore or be off-guard of the security threats involved and the precautions to be taken.

- Parents must ensure that students attend online classes under the supervision of parents/elders. This is required as students have a tendency to get easily distracted during an online class and indulge in non-academic online activities.
- Parents must ensure that students are attentive and maintain the decorum of the class. They must attend online classes with the required books, notebooks and stationery.
- Parents must monitor their ward's online activities and ensure that no inappropriate content (rumours, comments, memes, video) is posted online by their wards.
- In the absence of physical classes, students have a tendency to procrastinate and postpone the assigned work. This eventually leads to anxiety, stress and may have an adverse effect on the academic grades and the mental well-being of the child. Encourage your ward to be regular and complete work on time. Parents should provide the required assistance to their wards to complete the assigned tasks. Kindly keep a regular check on their notebooks, assignment and project submission schedules.
- Parents must spend quality time with their ward on a daily basis. It is of utmost importance that parents have open and free discussions with their wards.
- Parents must encourage them to devote some time to physical exercise everyday.
- Parents must keep a tab on net surfing habits of their wards.
- Parents are requested to contact the school counsellors to seek guidance and counselling as and when required.

GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS FOR ONLINE EXAMS

- In order to gauge students' understanding of basic concepts, test problem solving skills, develop conversational skills and to enable interaction between teacher and student on an individual basis, the school has planned an evaluation system which is a blend of written as well as oral assessment. In each term, one of the unit test cycles would be conducted as oral (viva assessment) and the other will be written assessment. This will be followed by semester/final exams. The detailed schedule and instructions for the assessments (both written and oral) will be uploaded on the school portal in advance.
- Parents should ensure availability of necessary devices (with working camera, microphone) and high-speed stable internet connection during the exam. Arrangements for availability of alternate options (mobile data) in case of power failure etc. should also be made.

- Parents should ensure that a quiet and peaceful atmosphere is provided as the student should stay unmuted throughout the exam.
- The students should not use headphones or wear smart watch during the exam.
- While attempting the written exam and submitting an answer, students must ensure that they submit the work of their own unaided efforts.
- Though teachers will be proctoring the online tests, parents are also requested to stay vigilant, monitor their ward and encourage them to appear for the exam with utmost sincerity and honesty to maintain the sanctity of the exam.
- Students should not indulge in unfair means during the examination. Candidates who are found to have participated in any form of cooperation or collusion or any activity which could amount to academic misconduct in the answering of this examination will have their marks deducted and a disciplinary action will be initiated.
- Parents must guide their ward and encourage them to write original answers. The students must refrain from copying answers from the internet. Disciplinary action will be taken if the students present answers that are plagiarised.
